I am writing this afternoon to advise you that we have recorded one new resident and one new staff member who have tested positive for the Coronavirus. These individuals are now quarantining in accordance with applicable infection control protocols.

Please note that, earlier today, we re-swabbed all of the residents for the virus once again, and have sent the materials to our laboratory for processing. We are doing so to ascertain if there are any additional COVID cases present. In this way, if we find that other, possibly asymptomatic, residents have the virus, we can immediately include them in our specific COVID unit infection protocols. Our end game is to quickly identify sources of the virus, isolate them, and prevent their transmission to others.

We are pleased to also note that one additional resident, who was on our COVID unit, has now recovered, and has transitioned off that unit.

We are very appreciative of the trust and confidence you have continued to place in our staff, and the patience you have exhibited as we work through the complications of the pandemic.
