We are exceedingly pleased to let you know that 9 residents of the Nursing & Rehabilitation Center were moved off the COVID unit today, having recovered from the virus. In case you were wondering, anyone who is moved off that unit has to first have negative test results on two separate occasions before being transferred.

Unfortunately, within the past day, we have had one resident pass away, having previously tested positive for the virus. We offer the family our deepest and sincerest condolences. May their loved one's memory be forever bound up in the eternal bonds of life...

Additionally, one other new resident has tested positive for the virus. We currently have 29 residents on the COVID unit.

Again, we want to thank the many of you who have sent back signed Vaccine Consent forms authorizing your loved one to receive the COVID-19 vaccine. If you would like your loved one to receive the vaccine, but have not yet returned the signed form, I would encourage you to do so promptly. I attach a another copy of the form for your convenience in completing it. Please write in your loved one's name, sign the form as the Responsible Party, and return a scanned copy (or a photo of the signed form) to [info@dosscc.org](mailto:info@dosscc.org). We are encouraging everyone to return a signed consent form **no later than Thursday, December 24<sup>th</sup>**.

If you have decided that you do not want your loved to get the vaccine, please reply to this email with the resident's name, your name, and a statement that you are declining the vaccine on your loved one's behalf.
