We are very pleased to inform you that, over the weekend, 13 residents were moved off of our COVID Unit due to the fact that they have recovered from the virus! Each of them has had two negative test results over the past several days, indicating that the virus has resolved itself. That reduces the total number of residents remaining on the COVID Unit to just 11.

Unfortunately, one resident on the COVID Unit did pass away this morning. We are heartbroken whenever that happens. On behalf of all of the staff at Daughters of Sarah, I express our sincerest condolences to the family. May their loved one's memory forever be for a blessing.

I again want to thank everyone for responding to our request for consents or declinations regarding the COVID vaccine. We are on pace to be ready for the clinic when our pharmacy provider arrives.

As we close out 2020, we once more thank you for the confidence and trust you have placed in Daughters of Sarah Community for Seniors. At the start of this year, no one at our campus ever envisioned facing the challenges we did for the past 10 months.
