I am writing to further advise you as to the Coronavirus circumstances at Daughters of Sarah Community for Seniors.

I regret to inform you that over the weekend we learned of a second COVID-19 positive test result with one of our staff members at the Nursing & Rehabilitation Center. As required, this individual has begun a quarantine period.

At this juncture, we have no residents at either the Nursing & Rehabilitation Center or The Massry Residence who have tested positive, or have shown symptoms of the virus.

We did inform you that, under CDC regulations, we were testing the residents of the Nursing & Rehabilitation Center. Swabs were taken last week and sent to the laboratory for processing. To date, no positive test results have been received.

In keeping with our practice, we will directly contact the family representative for any resident who happens to test positive. Otherwise, we will share the general results with everyone else through these Memoranda and on our Coronavirus Hotline (518-724-3203).

Under existing Department of Health regulations, indoor visitation remains suspended. Outdoor window visits remain available; if you would like one, please respond to this email, or call 518-724-3290 for **Nursing & Rehabilitation Center** visits or 518-724-3400 for **Massry Residence** visits.

We will let everyone know when indoor visitation will be able to resume.
