This note is being sent to update you on the results of our facility-wide COVID-19 testing at the Daughters of Sarah Nursing & Rehabilitation Center.

All of the first round of resident tests have been returned by the lab. Regrettably, one resident on the Gold Unit did test positive for the virus. That resident is asymptomatic; but, in accordance with our policy, has been transferred to our restricted COVID unit, and will quarantine there.

All of the remaining resident tests have returned as negative.

In keeping with CDC policy, we did re-swab all of the Nursing & Rehabilitation Center residents for a second time yesterday. As those results are processed by the lab, we will keep you informed of the results. If any new test is found to be positive, we will directly contact the family representative; otherwise, we will utilize these Memoranda and on our Coronavirus Hotline (518-724-3203) to share results.

There continue to be no residents at The Massry Residence who have tested positive, or have shown symptoms of the virus.

Under existing Department of Health regulations, indoor visitation remains suspended. Outdoor window visits remain available; if you would like one, please respond to this email, or call 518-724-3290 for **Nursing & Rehabilitation Center** visits or 518-724-3400 for **Massry Residence** visits.
