As we have already shared, over this past weekend we learned that a staff member from one of our contractors tested positive for the Coronavirus. This individual did not have contact with our residents, and is currently in quarantine. In compliance with regulations issued by the Federal Center for Disease Control, we immediately tested all residents of the Nursing & Rehabilitation Center for the virus.

**We are exceedingly pleased to report that every single one of the tests came back as negative for the virus.**

The CDC regulations require that, even if all of our first results are negative, we still perform certain follow-up tests to ensure that the virus is not incubating. Please be aware that we will perform those tests as, and when, required. If any test does come back positive for the virus, we will directly notify the resident and family involved; otherwise, we will continue to utilize these Memorandum and our Coronavirus Hotline to inform you of the results.

We regret that indoor visitation will remain on hold for at least the next two weeks. You will be notified when we are able to resume those arrangements.

If you have any questions in the meantime, please do not hesitate to call your loved one's social worker. As our staff is spending additional time coordinating virtual calls, window visits, as well as addressing resident needs, if you have to leave a message, we ask you to please be patient; you will get a call back.
