RE: COVID Update – Vaccine Update - Round #2

As you may know, our initial vaccine clinic proceeded exceedingly well, and we are very pleased with the number of residents and staff who have started their inoculations. We are now preparing for the next phases of the vaccine program.

For those residents who received a first dose of the vaccine:

The Nursing & Rehabilitation Center was provided with the Pfizer vaccine, which does require a second dose. Our pharmacy partner will be on-site to provide the second inoculation for residents on Wednesday, January 27, 2021.

Under Federal guidelines, anyone receiving the second dose must sign a new consent form, a copy of which is attached. As with the initial round, could you please print the attached form, sign it on behalf of your loved one, and return it to us by replying to this email (info@dosscc.org) immediately. You can return either a scanned copy of the signed form or a photograph of it.

As we do need to provide advance information to the pharmacy as to the number of vaccines doses they will be needing, we are requesting that you return the consent form to us no later than Wednesday, January 20, 2021.

For those residents who did not yet receive the vaccine, but would now like to:

It is possible for residents who may have missed the initial vaccine clinic for whatever reason to get their first dose. Our pharmacy provider has given us a date of January 31, 2021 for another clinic. (CVS will also provide the second dose later in February.)

As noted above, it is necessary for you to also complete the attached consent form and send us a scanned copy or photo of the signed form.

If you have decided that you **still do not** want your loved to get the vaccine, please reply to this email with the resident's name, your name, and a statement that you are continuing to decline the vaccine.

Please note that, within the past day, we have had 3 new staff member test positive for the virus. These individuals have begun their quarantine period.
