It has been a pleasure welcoming our friends and families back to the Nursing & Rehabilitation Center for indoor visits these past few weeks. I trust that those opportunities have been as rewarding for you as they have been for us.

At the same time, however, we do need to inform you that one of our staff members has just tested positive for the Coronavirus. This individual had been fully vaccinated, and is now quarantining at home.

In keeping with CDC outbreak procedures, earlier today we did test each of the facility's residents. We are pleased to note that all of those tests have returned as negative for the virus.

Pursuant to the revised Department of Health guidance on visitation, we are required to suspend in-house visits for the Green Unit (as that is the unit on which the staff member worked). For anyone who has scheduled a visit with a resident on the Green Unit for the upcoming week, we regret that your visit will have to be postponed.

In the meantime, visitation with residents from the other facility units can proceed as scheduled.

We will follow our outbreak testing protocols, and will keep you informed as to when visitation with residents from the Green Unit can resume.
