As you will recollect from yesterday's Memo (June 2, 2021), I advised you that one of our staff members had tested positive for the Coronavirus. I further indicated that we were awaiting clarification on visitation guidance from the Department of Health. We received that guidance this morning.

We are pleased to let you know that in-person visitation for the Red Unit, Green Unit, Blue Unit, and MEU can resume today. (The Gold Unit remains closed to visitors until June 6th, due to a prior staff positive test result on that unit a week or so ago.)

Accordingly, those of you with visits scheduled for this evening will be able to proceed as you planned. There are also a few open slots left for the rest of this week, if anyone who had a visit canceled yesterday is interested in signing up. Barring any further outbreak, all visits scheduled for next week can also occur as planned.

Please note that, in accord with the Department of Health guidance shared with us, three residents have been put on cautionary infection protocols as a result of this most recent incident. The families of these individuals have been contacted directly regarding their individual visitation options.
