RE: Campus COVID Update

With our ongoing outbreak testing, we have identified 1 additional resident of the Memory Enhancement Unit who has tested positive for the coronavirus, although this individual is not displaying any symptoms of the disease.

We regret to inform you that 2 of our residents who previously tested positive for the virus, and were displaying symptoms, have passed away. We offer their families our sincerest condolences. May their memories always be for an eternal blessing.

We are very pleased to note that 3 other formerly positive residents have fully recovered from COVID, and are no longer in isolation. Moreover, all staff, who are also tested as part of our outbreak testing, have been negative.

In sum, we only currently have a total of 7 residents remain in quarantine for the virus.

As a result, visitation rules remain unchanged. **Regular visits for the Red Unit and MEU are suspended. Regular visits with residents on the Green, Blue and Gold Units can continue, but will only be held outdoors, weather permitting.**

Please remember that virtual visits are also available, and can be scheduled with your loved one's social worker; window visits can be scheduled with Mary Roy (518-724-3290).
