RE: DOS Nursing & Rehabilitation Center COVID Update

We are notifying you that we completed our final round of outbreak testing this morning. All of the facility's residents have tested negative for the COVID virus. Moreover, as we continue to test them, no staff member has returned positive.

Accordingly, starting tomorrow – Tuesday, October 26th – we are able to return to indoor visitation throughout the Nursing & Rehabilitation Center! All visits should be scheduled online through *SignupGenius*. A link to the registration site is displayed on our website (www.dossc.org).

Given the recent situation limiting us to outdoor visitation only, and facing the shortening of daylight hours, we did suspend our 7 PM visitation slots. Starting next week, as we settle back into indoor visits, we will reestablish a few evening visitation slots to help accommodate everyone's needs. Again, when we are fully equipped to do so, those slots will open on *SignupGenius* commencing November 1st.

Please remember that, even though the weather is changing, window and virtual visits are still available. You should contact your loved one's social worker to schedule a virtual visit; or our Activities Director Mary Roy (518-724-3290) to set up a window visit.
