RE: Campus COVID Update

I am writing to update you as to the continuation of our outbreak testing of residents and staff at Daughters of Sarah Nursing & Rehabilitation Center. I regret to report that we have received additional positive test results.

We have learned of 1 new resident on the Memory Enhancement Unit testing positive for the virus. Additionally, 3 new residents have tested positive on the Red Unit. As a result, we currently have a total of 7 residents who have tested positive on MEU and 5 residents who have tested positive on the Red Unit.

Those residents having testing positive have been isolated in their rooms. Staff is wearing appropriate PPE for the conditions they are encountering.

Please note that visitation rules remain unchanged. **Regular visits for the Red Unit and MEU are suspended for at least the next 14 days. Regular visits with residents on the Green, Blue and Gold Units can continue, but will only be held outdoors, weather permitting.** As those of you who may have scheduled outdoor visits for today are aware, we have suspended those visits due to the weather. We will continue to make daily decisions based on the weather conditions.

Arrangements for outdoor visits with Green, Blue or Gold Unit residents can continue to be made online through *SignupGenius*. A link to the registration site is displayed on our website (www.dossc.org) - you should click on the "IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING CORONAVIRUS" link at the very top of the web homepage, then click on "*Click Here to Schedule a Resident Visit*".

Please remember that virtual visits are available, and can be scheduled with your loved one's social worker; window visits can be scheduled with Mary Roy (518-724-3290).
