Dear Family Members and Friends:

Over the past 24 hours we have had 6 staff members test positive for COVID-19. These staff will remain in quarantine until their completion date. We also released 5 staff members from quarantine and they are back working. As of today, we have 19 current staff positive cases.

We will be conducting full-house resident testing tomorrow, January 11, 2022, and will notify you of the results. Should your loved one test positive, we will contact you directly.

We continue to screen all staff before their shifts and are testing all staff who have been exposed to the virus wherever that exposure occurred. This is all in accordance with and following the recommendations of the CDC, CMS, and NYSDOH.

Many of you may have heard that Governor Hochul has mentioned requiring nursing home visitors to be tested within 24 hours of visiting. We do not have official regulations/guidelines on this ruling and are therefore not requiring it at this time. As we continue to be in an outbreak status and while we remain open to visitors, we ask that you wear your mask at all times.

As always, do not visit if you are exhibiting any signs and symptoms of COVID and/or if you have been exposed.
