Dear Family Members and Friends:

I am writing to inform you of some important updates in relation to nursing home visitation during this period of high COVID-19 infection rates.

You must wear a surgical (paper) mask when entering the facility. If you are wearing a cloth mask, please replace it with the surgical masks that are provided at the sign in kiosks.

Please do NOT visit if you are not feeling well and/or have been directly exposed to COVID-19.

We have updated our website and will be providing you with the number of new positive staff and resident cases. We will also provide the cumulative number of positive cases.

We do have 3 new staff positive cases, for a total of 14 staff positives. We released 1 resident from quarantine and currently have 1 resident positive who remains asymptomatic.

We continue to quarantine and test staff and residents per NYSDOH and CDC guidelines.

Currently 94% of our residents and 44% of our staff are boosted. We are holding another booster clinic Wednesday, January 11<sup>th</sup> for staff and residents.

We thank you for respecting the visitation rules in order to protect our residents. If you have any questions or concerns, please feel free to reach out to your loved ones' social worker.
