RE: Daughters of Sarah Nursing & Rehabilitation Center Update

As new COVID-19 cases continue to surge in the Capital District, I regret to advise you that we have had 2 new residents on the Green Unit of the Daughters of Sarah Nursing & Rehabilitation Center test positive for the virus. In addition, we also have noted 2 staff members who have tested positive, as well.

Following Department of Health directives, we are cohorting the residents testing positive in one section of the Unit. Moreover, staff have been instructed to wear appropriate personal protective equipment for the situation. Lastly, we continue with our regular outbreak testing of residents and staff.

I do want you to be aware that all of the residents who we reported had tested positive in previous weeks have recovered, and are no longer in quarantine. You should also note that, even though not required by the Department of Health, all of our staff are up to date in their vaccinations – including both the original vaccine and the booster shot.
