RE: Daughters of Sarah Nursing & Rehabilitation Center Update

Given our continued COVID outbreak testing protocols, we have identified 4 new residents who have tested positive for the virus. As one resident has recovered, this brings the total number of residents currently returning positive test results to 14. We will continue with regular testing this week as our protocols direct.

We have similarly learned of 2 new staff members who have also tested positive for the virus. Additionally, others of our staff who tested positive earlier on have recovered, reducing our total number of staff cases to 8 individuals.

Please note that the health regulations governing how long someone must remain in quarantine after testing positive for COVID do vary between residents and staff. For staff, as any symptoms resolve themselves, one need only quarantine for five (5) days; residents, on the other hand, do need to remain quarantined for at least ten (10) days. As a result, you will see reported total staff positive numbers tending to decline faster than those total numbers for residents.

We will cohort our positive Blue Unit and Gold Unit residents to minimize the risk of spreading the virus. Also, we have implemented a modified dining plan for all units to further ensure appropriate social distancing.

While we do envision periodically sending these Update Memoranda to you, I want to emphasize that our Website (daughtersofSarah.com) has a daily listing of COVID testing results that is updated as information becomes available. The link is at the very top of the landing page.
