RE: COVID-19 Update

We want to let you know that we have two residents who have tested positive for the Coronavirus. They are currently quarantining in their apartment for the next 10 days.

We have been in communication with the Albany County Health Department and Regional Department of Health.

Please be advised that you can continue to visit your loved ones. All visitors must be masked upon entering the building and must sign in using the Accushield kiosk to log and record their temperatures. We request that visitors proceed directly to their respective loved one's apartment and not congregate in the lobby or other common areas. Please do not share the elevators with residents other than your own loved one. Please continue to follow guidance for hand hygiene and social distancing.

Residents who test positive for COVID-19 or have symptoms associated with the virus will be allowed to have visitors in their own apartments per revised guidance from the New York State Department of Health (although visiting in those instance is not recommended).

Our daily routine and operations continue at The Massry Residence, including open dining rooms and activities for residents not in isolation or experiencing COVID-like symptoms. In-room dining will be provided for any resident who may be confined to his or her apartment.

Residents will continue to wear masks at all times during activities or while in common areas, except during meal service in the dining room.
