As you have undoubtedly seen in the press, the reported cases of COVID-19 are unfortunately ramping up again in Albany County. The current variants of the virus appear to be extremely contagious, and we should all re-double our attention to recommended inflection control protocols.

Please note that we currently have 3 residents who have tested positive for the virus. We are requiring them to stay quarantined in their apartments per CDC and DOH guidelines.

Most critically, to minimize the potential spread of the virus, please remember that it is very important that all residents, staff and visitors wear masks and maintain distancing at all times when they are out and about in the facility. (Residents may remove masks in the dining room solely for the purpose of eating, but must wear them at all other times that they are travelling through the facility, or are at activities.)

Moreover, to help limit the migration of the virus around the facility, we ask all visitors and guests to wear masks and maintain distances not only while moving through the building, but also while visiting in apartments. We realize that some inconvenience is associated with these requests; however, our concern for the health and safety of all of our residents remains our foremost goal.
