RE: Daughters of Sarah Nursing & Rehabilitation Center Update

We are writing today to apprise you of recent circumstances in the Nursing & Rehabilitation Center related to the Coronavirus.

At present we have a minor outbreak of COVID cases on our Blue Unit. Currently, there are 5 residents on the Unit who have tested positive for the virus. These residents are being quarantined in their rooms in accordance with CDC recommendations.

Staff are wearing all appropriate Personal Protective Equipment necessitated by the outbreak. We are also testing all of the residents on the Unit on a periodic basis in accord with CDC directives and our outbreak protocols.

In keeping with our Infection Control policies, to trustfully minimize the spread of the virus, we have temporarily closed all group activities on the Blue Unit, as well as communal dining for that Unit.

Visitation with residents may continue as in the past; however, we do recommend, if you are personally susceptible to the virus or otherwise concerned about possible infection, that you consider postponing your visits at this time. Moreover, if you feel unwell yourself, we ask that you stay home and recuperate.

I do want to remind you that, for your convenience, daily information regarding the number of resident and staff who have contracted COVID is listed on our Website under the "COVID-19" link at the top of each page.
