Please be aware that we are continuing to see a spread of COVID-19 in The Massry Residence at Daughters of Sarah. As of overnight and this morning, we have recorded ten (10) new cases of residents testing positive for the virus, bringing the total number of cases in the building to 12.

In keeping with our infection protocols, we have tested the entire facility, and will continue to do so on a scheduled basis over the next several days. Moreover, to minimize any continued spread of the virus, we have temporarily suspended communal dining and group activities, and residents are being asked to remain in their rooms. We continue to screen all residents regularly for symptoms of the virus.

As determined by our infection procedures, ongoing test results will outline the duration of these various protective measures.

Visitation by compassionate care givers and family members can continue, although, for the safety of residents, staff and yourselves, we suggest that you limit the frequency and extent of any visits. We are also requesting that visitors wear KN95 masks throughout their visits. (Compassionate care givers visiting residents who have tested positive will be asked to also wear protective gowns and face shields.) Again, if you are not feeling well yourself, please remain at home, and not risk infecting others.
